COMMUNION

- At some point during your gathering, take communion together.
- Share a Scripture about the love of Jesus displayed in His sacrificial death
- Or use John 10:11–13; 17–18
- spend a moment in silence to experience the presence of Christ

REVIEW

- Jesus said that His sheep know Him and hear His voice
- Hearing God's voice is fundamentally about knowing God and knowing God's heart
- You may not know God fully, but Jesus has fully established your relationship with Him
- Learning to hear God's voice is the most important task of a disciple of Jesus. Learning to obey His voice is even more important
- God speaks in a variety of ways, many of which are unfamiliar to us
- Hearing God also requires learning to sift through the many voices vying for our attention

DISCUSSION

1. What stuck out to you from this week's teaching?
2. Have you ever tried to listen for God's voice before?
3. What concerns or fears do you have about this part of our relationship with God?

Read John 10:14–16

4. What's the primary way that you hear God's voice in your life?
5. Which exercises did you try this week? What was your experience?
6. Can you share something you think God spoke to you this week?
7. Can you share something God directed you to do that you need to obey?
