SOLITUDE - FACING OUR ENEMIES - 6/09/2024

COMMUNION

- At some point during your gathering, take communion together.
- Share a Scripture about Jesus defeating evil or use 1 John 3:1–8
- · spend a moment in silence to experience the presence of Christ

REVIEW

- The three enemies of our soul: the world, the flesh and the devil. An unholy trinity seeking to destroy the image of God in humanity
- Solitude and Silence is the place we face these enemies with greater clarity
- The battle is a quiet spiritual battle in the mind and heart. Jesus sees some thoughts and mindsets as coming from God and others as satanic in nature
- The devil looks for an opportunity, speaks in the form of thoughts, that lead to behaviors and choices that destroy us, our relationship to God and our relationships with others
- Two important christian practices for spiritual warfare are forgiveness and devotion to the teachings of Jesus

DISCUSSION

1. How did your practice of solitude go this week?

Read: Mark 1:9-13

- 2. What stood out to you from this week's teachings?
- 3. What resistance might you need to work through as you enter the desert place of solitude?
- 4. Have you ever thought about the desert as a place of strength? Where can you see this play out in your own life?
- 5. How might remembering that solitude is a place of resisting the world, the flesh, and the devil help you in your practice of solitude?
