REVIEW

- When we speak of our identity we generally mean both our sense of self and where we get our sense of worth from.
- Our culture's approach to identity is something we create or discover through self analysis. Biblically, our identity is a gift we receive, not a goal we achieve
- Our culture's approach to identity is incoherent, unstable and illusory.
- Our true identity is found IN CHRIST
- This week we explored our identity as the temple of God's dwelling an important theme from the first to last pages of the Bible
- The Temple represents sacred space where heaven and earth intersect and God's presence is manifested. It is a place of encounter and sacrifice/offering and worship.
