COMMUNION

- At some point during your gathering, take communion together.
- Read a Scripture about God's blessing in Christ or use Ephesians 1:3-6
- spend a moment in silence to experience the presence of Christ

REVIEW

- how we talk to and about people opens a window into our heart and tells the real truth about our character
- God designed words for life and blessing. Words matter. How we use our words matters
- How we use our words is a measure of our spiritual maturity (not the only measure, but an important measure)
- The tongue, like the **bit** and the **rudder**, is small, yet it has a large impact and far reaching consequences so learn how to it for good
- Our tongue can be as destructive as a fire and harder to tame than a wild beast
- James says the match that makes your tongue a spark is none other than the fires of hell
- According to the Bible, our words should be a thing of beauty and bring delight to others (like ripe figs or fresh water)
- When we recognize and affirm the image of God in ourselves and in others; we bless others, and in the process, we worship and bless the God who created them
