COMMUNION

- At some point during your gathering, take communion together.
- Read a Scripture about peace in Christ or use Romans 5:1
- spend a moment in silence to experience the presence of Christ

REVIEW

- The Hebrew word in the Bible for peace is shalom
- Shalom is more than the absence of conflict, it is the presence of something better in its place. Shalom means wholeness or to be complete
- Shalom is the presence of harmony and order and beauty where everything is working the way it is supposed to work in our relationships, our finances, our health, our communities
- 3 enemies of the soul: the world, the flesh and the devil. The devil speaks lies that appeal to our disordered desires (which are often normalized by the culture we live in).
- When we believe lies, it undermines our relationship with God, with ourself and with others
- Jesus said the truth will set us free (John 8:32)
- peace comes when we trust Jesus completely
- With the peace of God we can become peace-makers. The way of peace according to Jesus is humilty, confession, repentence, forgiveness and self sacrificial love
- Though His death on the cross, Jesus has made peace (between us and God and between humans).
